2017 Mileage Reimbursement

Dear Provider:

Optum would like to make you aware of an upcoming change taking place to your Optum fee schedule for Idaho Medicaid members.

Effective March 1, 2017, Optum is adding a billing code for provider mileage reimbursement to be used for the following identified services:

- Family Psychotherapy (only billing codes with member present)
- Individual Psychotherapy (all billing codes)

The code may only be used when services are delivered at the Member’s home. Billing thresholds for Family and/or Individual Psychotherapy are expected to continue at current frequency and intensity. This code is exclusively for the Idaho Medicaid and not a part of the commercial or Medicare Advantage benefit/fee schedule.

The following parameters must also be met:

- The services must be provided in a setting that is safe, confidential, and appropriate to the Member’s needs
- The services must be provided by a qualified licensed clinician
- The Psychotherapy provided must be an Evidence Based Practice (EBP) when used in combination with this mileage reimbursement
- The need and appropriateness of providing in-home treatment must be documented in the clinical chart
