Day Treatment update

Alert Summary: This alert details an update to the Optum Idaho Level of Care Guideline (LOCG) for CHILDREN AND ADOLESCENT SERVICES: DAY TREATMENT.

Dear Provider,

Thank you for your ongoing partnership as we continue with the implementation and enhancement of the services offered to child and adolescent Medicaid members.

The Optum Idaho LOCG for children and adolescent Day Treatment services was updated to remove the requirement that a member must attend a day treatment program at a minimum of 20 hours per week. However, in order for a provider to submit claims, the child or adolescent member is required to participate in a structured Day Treatment program 4-5 days per week with a minimum of 3 hours per day and a maximum of 5 hours per day.
