As part of Idaho's YES System of Care, Optum Idaho has created a training to outline Idaho-specific components in providing TASSP. Therapeutic After School and Summer Programs are structured programs that consist of therapeutic, recreational and socialization activities individualized for youth. The goal of TASSP is to enable each youth to improve their functioning in the home, school and community by providing structured treatment services during after-school, summer or out-of-school time. As a provider of services to Medicaid-eligible youth, you are encouraged to take our TASSP training available through Optum Idaho Relias Learning.

Once you have completed this training, you will be able to:

1. Explain the definition of TASSP in your own words.
2. Identify at least two billable service where coordination with a TASSP can be utilized.
3. List at least one TASSP activity in your community that may benefit one of your youth members.
